Committee Members: Richard Newcombe was prepared to remain as a committee member. No other volunteers for the committee came forward.

Accounts: Sue tabled a draft set of accounts. These are still work in progress, as there are still some outstanding match fees from the season and rent to pay on the venues. The headline figures were as follows:

Balance carried forward: £2,536

Subscriptions: It was agreed to keep the current level of subscriptions and match fees to £5 per session/match. The "twice/week" rule was clarified as: "During the league season, if a league player attends a practice session on the same week as he/she has a match, then the practice session is free and he/she will need to play the team captain a £5 match fee. This concession only applies to league matches – if a player turns up to play twice a week, then it is £5 per session."
